ATTENDANCE

MINUTES

Mr. Darosh made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 2025 meeting. Mr. DiBiase seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mr. DiBiase made a motion to approve the March Financial Report. Mr. Olenick seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

VISITORS

There were no visitors at the April meeting.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT

The Solicitor was not present at the April meeting.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Don Cuff informed the Authority they have been awarded an \$87,000 grant and a low interest, 1% for 30 years, loan for the UV Project. Mr. DiBiase made a motion, second by Mr. Darosh to accept the grant and loan offer from Penn Vest. The motion passed as presented.

Mr. DiBiase made a motion to approve Requisition #58 in the amount of \$22,678.75 for bond related engineering and design for the UV Project. Mr. Darosh seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

Mr. Darosh made a motion, second by Mr. Olenick to approve advertising to bid on the UV Project. The motion passed as presented.

Mr. Rizzardi made a motion to approve the Engineering Work Order for the Pump Station Emergency Generator Project. On the question, Mr. Olenick stated the electrician should inspect the site until the generator arrives. Mr. DiBiase seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

Don Cuff reported Mr. Reber is still awaiting approval to put fish back into the pond.

Mr. Cuff stated an invoice for fire related repairs is being sent to the insurance company.

SEWER OPERATOR'S REPORT

Mr. Sukeena presented members with a written report.

CORRESPONDENCE: There was no new correspondence.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no Unfinished Business to discuss.

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Sukeena requested the Authority hire to same two summer workers as last year. Mr. Sukeena stated they were good workers.
