MINUTES

Mr. Darosh made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 2024 meeting. Mr. Rizzardi seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mr. Darosh made a motion to approve the Financial Report for July 2024, second by Mr. Rizzardi. The motion passed as presented.

VISITORS

Mr. Bowers, of 317 Arlene Street questioned his reimbursement for outside services of his sewer line. He will forward the bill to Mr. Mahalchick for payment.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT

The Solicitor was not present at the August meeting.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Cuff responded to issues brought up at the Borough Council meeting in August. Mr. Cuff stated there was originally a delay in testing the materials but it has been resolved. When questioned about issues brought up at the August Borough Council meeting by both the Mayor and Mr. Wigoda, Mr. Cuff responded that purchasing a generator is at least 9 months out. Renting a generator would be available in a week. He stated there is no guarantee the issue would never be repeated. Inspection could be done one day and an issue could arise the next. Mr. Cuff will present a timeline of the responses to the issue at Mr. Reber's pond to the council.

SEWER OPERATOR'S REPORT

Mr. Sukeena presented members with a written report. Mr. Sukeena reported the main on Sunbury Street was damaged during the Streetscape Project and they will be responsible for the financing of repairs.

CORRESPONDENCE: A motion was made to forgive Kim Hughes, 615 Sunbury Street, for excessive charges on her sewer bill due to a water leak.
