An Emergency meeting of the Sewer Authority of the Borough of Minersville was held Monday, June 16, 2025 in Council Chambers, North Delaware Avenue and East Carbon Street. Chairman Tom Eltringham opened the meeting with the flag ceremony at 7:00PM.

The following members attended the meeting-Jeff Rizzardi, Jeremy Olenick, Tom Eltringham, Rich DiBiase, Steve Darosh, Solicitor Pellish, Engineer Don Cuff and Plant Manager Ray Sukeena.

Mr. Sukeena informed the Authority of accusations of scrap metal theft by Councilman Enders. Mr. Sukeena stated Police Chief Bowers investigated and the accusations were not substantiated. Mr. Sukeena reported that plant employee Carvajal was asked about DEP inspections by Councilman Enders.

Solicitor Pellish stated the above was discussed at an emergency council meeting at which point Solicitor Pellish asked for councilman Enders be taken off of the Borough Sewer Committee. Council president Slovick refused. Solicitor Pellish suggested sending a letter to councilman Enders asking him to not contact Sewer Department employees or Authority member and sending a letter to the borough council that if they want to visit the plant they contact Chairman Eltringham.

The Authority went to Executive Session. Following Executive Session, moving forward, a sign in book will be at the plant requiring signatures, nature of business, etc.

Mr. Darosh made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Rizzardi seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
