ATTENDANCE

MINUTES

Mr. Darosh made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 2024 meeting. Mr. Olenick seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mr. DiBiase made a motion to approve the Financial Report for April 2024, second by Mr. Rizzardi. The motion passed as presented.

VISITORS

There were no visitors at the May meeting.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT

The Solicitor was not present at the May meeting.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Cuff was not present at the May meeting. Mr. DiBiase made a motion to approve Requisition # 51 in the amount of \$253,432.85 made up of payments to Entech for Bond related Engineering in the amount of \$830.00 and Krammes Excavating for 50% down payment on work at Reber Pond in the amount of \$252,602.85. The motion passed as presented. Mr. Darosh questioned who would be overseeing the project at Reber Pond. Mr. Sukeena reported Don Cuff would ask for slips for the landfill.

Mr. DiBiase made a motion to approve payment to HNT, LLC in the amount of \$11,676.00 as down payment for sludge testing of the Reber Pond. Mr. Olenick seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

Mr. Rizzardi made a motion, second by Mr. Olenick to approve the purchase of seven 20-pound fire extinguishers for the plant from Susquehanna Fire.

SEWER OPERATOR'S REPORT

Mr. Sukeena presented members with a written report. Mr. Sukeena reported clean—up still needs to be done from the fire. Mr. Sukeena reported we could borrow a jetter from Frackville if needed.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no Unfinished Business.

OLD BUSINESS

The request of Diane Urban to remove the charge of \$103.48 from her sewer charges was approved. She has five meters, four are for apartments but the 5th only is used as a floor drain in the basement.

NEW BUSINESS

There was a collapsed six feet of clay pipe at the home of Mr. Hranchock. He shares the line with neighbors. The neighbors will replace the pipe.

Mr. Darosh made a motion to adjourn, Mr. DiBiase seconded the motion.
