A general meeting of the Sewer Authority of the Borough of Minersville was held Wednesday, May 28, 2025 in Council Chambers, North Delaware Avenue and East Carbon Street. Chairman Tom Eltringham opened the meeting with the flag ceremony at 7:00PM.

**ATTENDANCE**

The following members attended the May meeting-Tom Eltringham, Rich DiBiase, Steve Darosh, Plant Manager Ray Sukeena and Borough Manager Mark Dasch.

**MINUTES**

Mr. DiBiase made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 2025 meeting. Mr. Darosh seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

**FINANCIAL REPORT**

Mr. Darosh made a motion to approve the April Financial Report. Mr. DiBiase seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

**VISITORS**

There were no visitors at the May meeting.

**SOLICITOR'S REPORT**

The Solicitor was not present at the May meeting.

**ENGINEER'S REPORT**

Don Cuff was not present at the May meeting. Mr. DiBiase made a motion, second by Mr. Darosh to approve Requisition #59 in the amount of \$10,735.00, which includes a reimbursement of \$7,695.00 to the Sewer Authority for restocking of Reber's Pond.

A motion was made by Mr. Darosh, second by Mr. DiBiase to accept and award the bid for UV Light Disinfection System for general mechanical to Blooming Glen in the amount of \$1,091,329.00 and electrical contract to PSI Pumping Solutions in the amount of \$50,824.00. The motion passed as presented.

The approving of docking stations at Heritage Heights and Norwegian Woods Pump Stations was tabled pending more information from the engineer.

**SEWER OPERATOR'S REPORT**

Mr. Sukeena presented members with a written report. Mr. Sukeena reported a blockage at 42 Lytle Street and root cutting at 223 South Delaware Avenue.

**CORRESPONDENCE:**

Mr. DiBiase made a motion, second by Mr. Darosh to not bill John Sep at 432 New Castle Street for sewer services, as there is no toilet or drain. The motion passed as presented.

A thank you note was received from the family of Gerry Maley upon his passing.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

The Authority is requesting confirmation from Mr. Reber's attorney that the payment for restocking the pond constituted no further obligations to Mr. Reber.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Mr. Dasch informed the Authority on Sewer Authority objectifies for a 90-day assessment. Sewer mapping is currently being done by one of the summer hires. The sewer staff has fabricated a form for drains. Plant non-functioning equipment is being removed.
