Thanks to Mr. Olenick for his input, including an addendum to the service contract to include a warranty clause for 5-10 yrs and a 3-5 year service contract, which saved the Authority substantial funds.

Mr. Sukeena presented members with a written report. Mr. Sukeena reported sampling for the permit renewal was done today.

CORRESPONDENCE:

Following discussion, Mr. DiBiase made a motion, second by Mr. Olenick to deny the request of the home owner at 111 Josephine Street reimbursement for filling their pool and that going forward this will not be reimbursed. The motion passed as presented.
