**MINUTES**

will look at including an addendum to the service contract to include a warranty clause for 5-10 yrs and a 3-5 year service contract.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

The Authority received an estimate of digital recorder for Norwegian Township flow. Mr. Cuff stated they are working to get the information from Norwegian Township so this item may not be necessary at this time. The Board recommend tabling until more information is provided.
