Engineers Report:

Mr. Cuff reported New Castle St is scheduled to be repaved on May 25. He spoke with a homeowner that said there are other issues regarding the sidewalks and the temporary restoration.

Solicitors' Report:

Attorney Evans reported that neither he nor Mr. Fran Green heard back from Northpoint Development. Mr. Cuff has not hear back from them either. Mr. Reber suggested that the Authority keeps the mineral rights on the property if it is sold.

Manager's Report:

Ms. Spittler reported the Authority received \$250 from S&J and \$2024 from M&D Mine. The Authority did not received timber checks yet but they did start on Saturday.

Ms. Spittler also reported there was a major leak found in a stream culvert on Valley Rd. The water authority laborers found it and fixed it live. It was a 2" tap.

Filtration Plant Report:

The effluent valve at the plant malfunctioned which cut off water to the town. Because of the higher elevation, New Minersville, West West Terrace, and Jonestown were on a water boil advisory from 5/5/25-5/8/25.

Treasurers Report:

Mr. Allen Reber made a motion to accept the April Treasurer's Report. Mr. Kevin Wigoda seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

Presentation of Bills:
