ATTENDANCE

MINUTES

Mr. Angelo made a motion to approve the August 2017 minutes. Mr. Olenick seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

VISITORS

There were no visitors at the September meeting.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mr. Angelo made a motion to approve the July Financial report. Mr. DiBiase seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

Mr. Bobinas made a motion to approve the August Financial report. Mr. Angelo seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

Mr. Sukeena reminded Authority members that the bill from Blooming Glen is not on the current expense list.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Don Cuff reported that training would be available on the GPS layered computer system for employees as soon as time permits. The last street-by-street mapping for sewer and storm water was done twenty years ago.

SEWER OPERATOR'S REPORT

Mr. Sukeena shared a written report with Authority members. Additionally he reported that the pump at the Heritage Heights pumping station blew up and the back up is being rebuilt.

Trees have been cut down on the access road on Teaberry Hill.

Mr. Angelo stated that when streets are paved, risers need to be put onto the manhole covers.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT

The Solicitor was not present at the September 2017 meeting.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A review of the Norwegian Township customer list will wait until after the November election.

OLD BUSINESS

There was no Old Business to discuss.

CORRESPONDENCE

Mr. Angelo made a motion, second by Mr. Olenick to contract out for the root cutter and jetter with seventy feet to be televised.
