SEWER OPERATOR'S REPORT

Mr. Sukeena presented members with a written report. Mr. Sukeena reported that the plant had one violation of the NPDES permit in June. The violation has been remedied. The press pumps are in place. Adjustments to the settings need to be made before start-up.

Mr. Sukeena reported he would be working the Engineer to investigate the inlet that runs from the high school baseball field to the area Rodnicks Grocery store. It may be collapsing. A point to enter to video the line needs to be found.

There are five major repairs that need to be done to inlets in the borough. Quality Street will need a complete rebuild. Six need heavy cleaning. When there are sufficient heavy cleaning projects, a company will be called to do the work.

A major repair on New Castle Street was completed.
