

2015 International Property Maintenance Code (2015 IPMC) Barrier Requirements: 303.2 Enclosures. Private swimming pools, hot tubs and spas, containing water more than 24 inches in depth shall be completely surrounded by a fence or barrier at least 48 inches in height above the finished ground level measured on the side of the barrier away from the pool. Gates and doors in such barriers shall be self-closing and self-latching. Where the self-latching device is less than 54 inches above the bottom of the gate, the release mechanism shall be located on the pool side of the gate. Self-closing and self-latching gates shall be maintained such that the gate will positively close and latch when release from an open position of 6 inches from the gatepost. No existing pool enclosure shall be removed, replaced or changed in a manner that reduces its effectiveness as a safety barrier.

Minimum Temporary/Seasonal Pool Requirements:

- 1. The 2015 International Property Maintenance Code (2015 IPMC), which has been adopted by the Borough of Minersville requires private swimming pools, hot tubs and spas, containing water more than 24 inches in depth to be completely surrounded by a fence or barrier at least 48 inches in height above the finished ground level measured on the side of the barrier away from the pool.
- 2. Gates and doors in such barriers shall be self-closing and self-latching. Where the self-latching device is less than 54 inches above the bottom of the gate, the release mechanism shall be located on the pool side of the gate. Self-closing and self-latching gates shall be maintained such that the gate will positively close and latch when released from an open position of 6 inches from the gatepost.
- 3. No existing pool enclosure shall be removed, replaced or changed in a manner that reduces its effectiveness as a safety barrier.
- 4. Pool must be located at least 10 feet away from overhead electrical lines-horizontal clearance.
- 5. Pool must be located at least 5 feet away from underground electrical lines-horizontal clearance.
- 6. Stagnant water is not allowed; all pools must be maintained.
- 7. Registration is not required for inflatable or movable pools less than 24 inches in depth.
- 8. Pool must be placed at least 3 feet from any property line.
- 9. Separate permits are required for new construction of barriers/fences. Temporary fences and/or barriers will not meet the fencing/barrier requirements.
- 10. Pool pumps must be connected to a GFCI Receptacles 125 volt, 15 or 20 amp, which is no less than 10 feet away from the pool. No pool can be run off an extension cord of any kind.



11. Draining of the pool must be done as to not cause a public nuisance.

What do I need to submit in order to register my temporary/seasonal pool at a rental unit?

Along with a completed Temporary/Seasonal Pool Application form, please submit a letter from the property owner granting permission for a temporary/seasonal pool installation on the property.

Is there a fee to register my Temporary/Seasonal Pool?

Yes, an inspection fee of \$10 and the Labor and Industry permit fee apply.

Do I need an inspection of my Temporary/Seasonal pool?

Yes. The Borough of Minersville Code Enforcement Officer will complete a brief inspection of the property to confirm the existence of the barrier/fence and electrical hookup (if required).
