ATTENDANCE

MINUTES

Mr. Darosh made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 2023 meeting. Mr. Olenick seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mr. Enders made a motion to approve the April Treasurer's Report. Mr. Olenick seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

Mr. Darosh made a motion to approve the May Treasurer's Report. Mr. Olenick seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Enders made a motion, second by Mr. DiBiase to approve Requisition #42 in the amount of \$5,207.15, which represented payment to the Pottsville Republican of \$424.65, and Entech in the amount of \$1,192.50 for bond related engineering and \$3,590.00 for the Delaware Avenue Storm Project. The motion passed as presented.

Don Cuff reported the Delaware Avenue Storm Water Project would begin the first week of September.

Don Cuff reported there would be a meeting on August 3 at 8:30 at Reber's Pond with another engineer. There is still some of level of contamination at the pond but the source needs to be determined.

SEWER OPERATOR'S REPORT

Ray Sukeena presented members with a written report. Mr. Sukeena stated a new storm inlet was installed on North Third Street to hopefully eliminate the storm water issues at 312 North Third Street. Mr. Sukeena presented a price on a new work truck with costars price of \$42,446.00. The current truck will not pass inspection. Mr. Sukeena stated the current truck would be used for plowing within the plant area. Mr. Enders made a motion to purchase the truck with funds from the General Reserve. Mr. Darosh seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented. Mr. Sukeena stated the summer help has been working well.

CORRESPONDENCE

There was no correspondence.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Mr. Enders stated he helped the residents on Delaware Avenue with their connection to the sewer line. Don Cuff reported that the contractor is working with the resident who has issues with blocked drains. The rocks have been removed from the street drain at the former Ulmer home.
