ATTENDANCE

MINUTES

Mr. DiBiase made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 2023 meeting. Mr. Enders seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented

FINANCIAL REPORT

The Financial Report was not available for the June meeting. Mr. Darosh made a motion, second by Mr. DiBiase to review the report when it is available. The motion passed as presented.

VISITORS

The resident of 313 Delaware Avenue believes the water line replacement and street repaving on Delaware Avenue has led to water damage in her basement. She gave a list of damage from the flooding. Following discussion, the Authority will inspect the area following tonight's meeting. The resident of 326 Delaware Avenue reports water will not go down any drains in the home. She contacted the borough and was treated rudely by the person answering the phone on several occasions. She had her line inspected with a camera and found the terra cotta was broken. She has replaced the line within her property but needs connection to the main. Following discussion, which revealed a resident at the former Ulmer home on Delaware Avenue, had filled the storm drain with stone to combat the sewer smell. That problem had been discussed at a previous Council Meeting. Gloria Capik will email Authority members the minutes from that meeting. The Authority will inspect the area following tonight's meeting.

Mr. DiBiase made a motion, second by Mr. Enders to award the bid for the Delaware Storm Water Project to the low bidder, PACT, in the amount of \$290,422.00. The motion passed as presented. Don Cuff reported he does not concur with the sampling at Reber Pond. He will talk with another firm as agreed by the Authority.
